

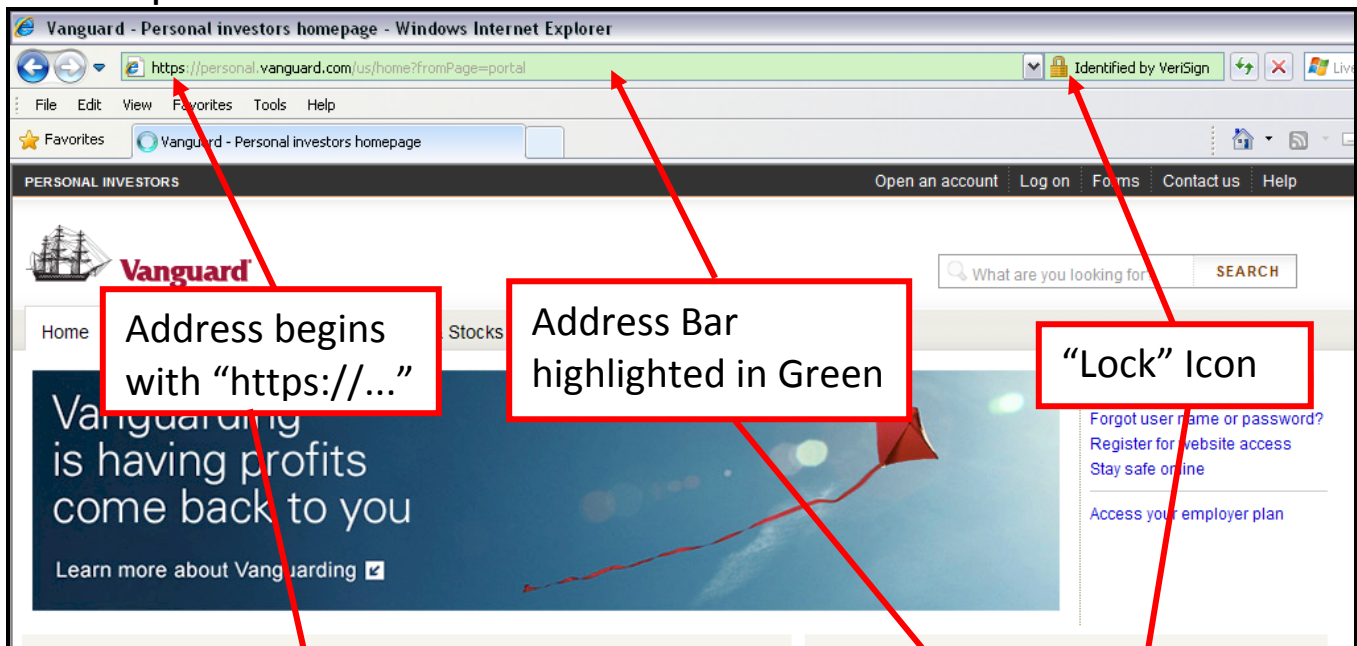

April Newsletter Addendum – Browsing Secure Websites

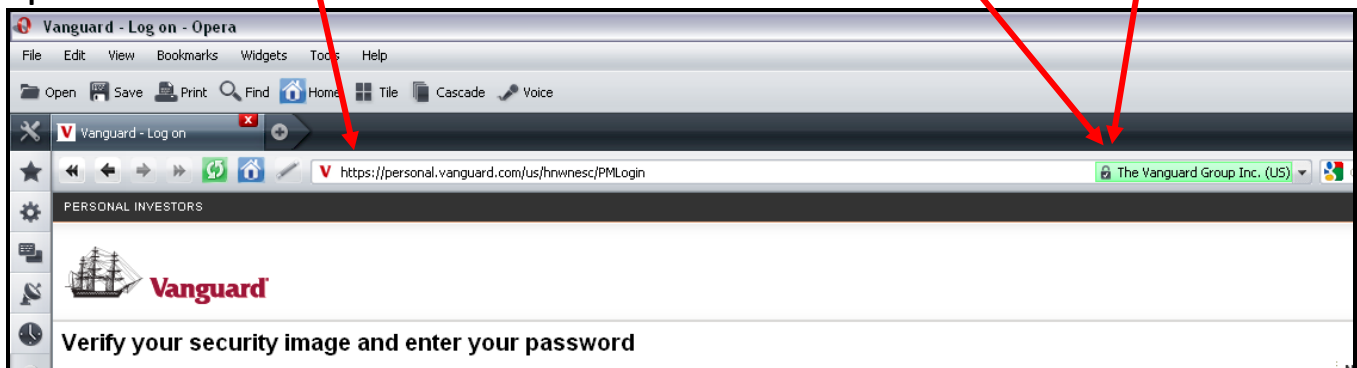
To securely view a website, you also need to be using a browser that itself is secure. I'm probably going to set off a firestorm of criticism, but the only two browsers I currently consider secure are **Internet Explorer 8** and **Opera 9.6** (as of April, 2010).

Everyone has their preferences as far as neat features, cool add-ons, speed, and compatibility - and that is fine for recreational browsing. But if you want to be secure, you'll have to use a secure browser. Don't be fooled by what's popular or "cool". Should you find reviews that rank other browsers as "better", read carefully: those reviews typically weight categories such as ease-of-use, speed, or features more heavily than security.
