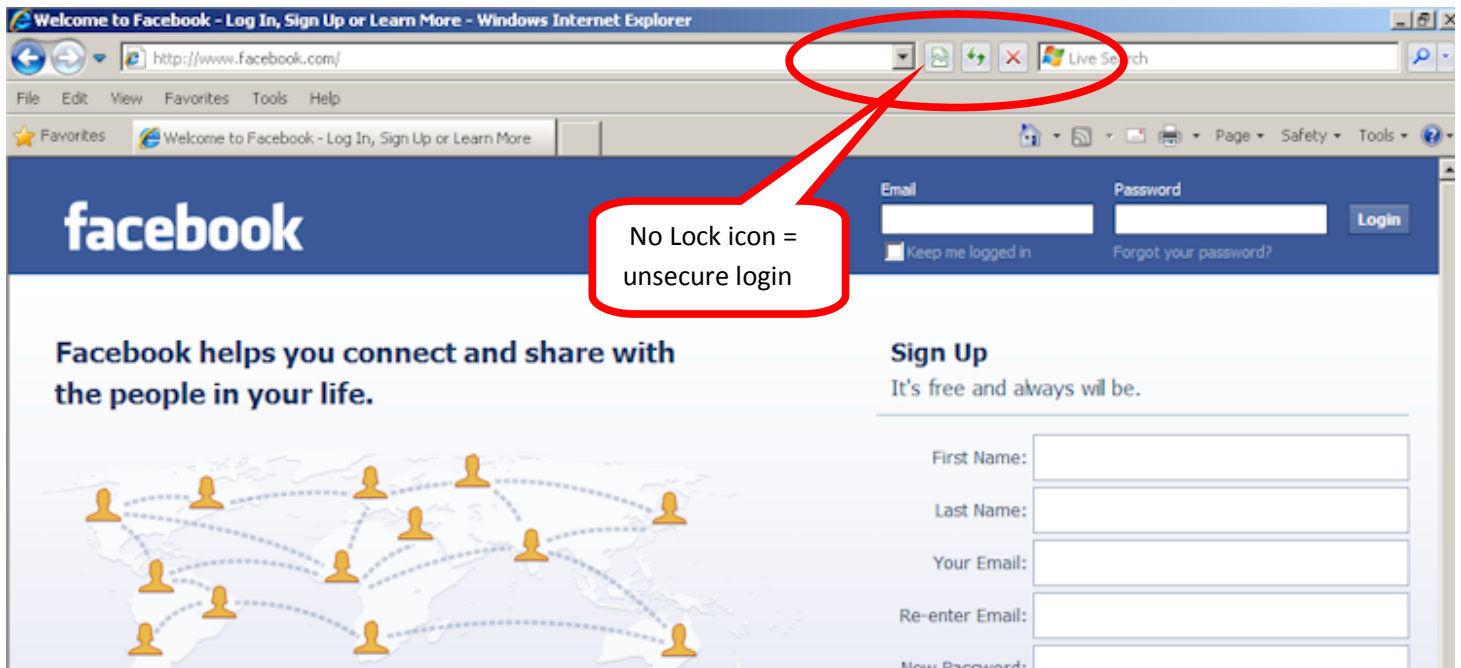


## Unsecure vs. Secure Login Examples

Using Facebook.com as an example, (as of February 20, 2011) this is an unsecure (no SSL) login page. Without the SSL Lock icon, your password can be intercepted, captured, and used without your knowing it. Facebook will be implementing SSL login by the end of 2011, but the same principle applies to any website that does not use SSL login.



Using LinkedIn.com as an example, this is what a secure SSL login page looks like. The lock icon ensures your password is safe by encrypting it as it is sent to the login server.
